## A BILL

To authorize an extension and expansion of the reimbursable screening services program of the Transportation Security Administration, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reimbursable Screen-  
5 ing Services Program Extension Act of 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION AND EXPANSION OF REIMBURSABLE**  
2 **SCREENING SERVICES PROGRAM.**

3 (a) **EXTENSION.**—Subsection (e) of section 225 of di-  
4 vision A of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2019  
5 (Public Law 116–6; 49 U.S.C. 44901 note), is amended  
6 by striking “for fiscal years 2019 through 2026” and in-  
7 serting “through fiscal year 2031”.

8 (b) **EXPANSION.**—Subsection (e) of section 225 of di-  
9 vision A of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2019, as  
10 amended by subsection (a), is further amended by striking  
11 “not more than eight” and inserting “not more than 14”.
