

PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE BILL (H.R. 1501) TO AMEND THE FAST ACT TO INCLUDE CERTAIN MINERAL PRODUCTION ACTIVITIES AS A COVERED PROJECT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE BILL (H.R. 9436) TO AMEND THE CONSOLIDATED APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 2023 TO EXTEND THE TIME PERIOD FOR WHICH CERTAIN REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE NORTH ATLANTIC RIGHT WHALE ARE EFFECTIVE; PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE RESOLUTION (H. RES. 1490) PROVIDING FOR THE CONDEMNATION AND DENOUNCEMENT OF SOCIALISM IN ALL ITS FORMS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES; PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE BILL (H.R. 4795) TO AMEND THE HIGHER EDUCATION ACT OF 1965 TO PROHIBIT AN INSTITUTION THAT PARTICIPATES IN A NONEXPRESSIVE COMMERCIAL BOYCOTT OF ISRAEL FROM BEING ELIGIBLE FOR CERTAIN FUNDS UNDER THAT ACT, TO REQUIRE AN INSTITUTION THAT PARTICIPATES IN CERTAIN PROGRAMS UNDER THAT ACT TO CERTIFY THAT STUDENTS ARE NOT UNREASONABLY OBSTRUCTED FROM PARTICIPATING IN ACADEMIC PROGRAMS IN ISRAEL, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES; AND RELATING TO CONSIDERATION OF MOTIONS TO SUSPEND THE RULES.

The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution ____, by a record vote of 7 to 4, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for consideration of H.R. 1501, the Protecting Domestic Mining Act of 2025, under a closed rule. The resolution waives all points of order against consideration of the bill. The resolution provides that the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Natural Resources now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted and the bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. The resolution waives all points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended. The resolution provides one hour of general debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Natural Resources or their respective designees. The resolution provides for one motion to recommit. The resolution further provides for consideration of H.R. 9436, the Northeast Lobsterman Protection Act of 2026, under a closed rule. The resolution waives all points of order against consideration of the bill. The resolution provides that, in lieu of the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Natural Resources now printed in the bill, an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 119-40 shall be considered as adopted and the bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. The resolution waives all points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended. The resolution provides one hour of general debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Natural Resources or their respective designees. The resolution provides for one motion to recommit. The resolution further provides for consideration of H. Res. 1490, Providing for the condemnation and denouncement of socialism in all its forms, and for other purposes, under a closed rule. The resolution provides that upon adoption of the resolution it shall be in order without intervention of any point of order to consider H. Res. 1490. The resolution provides that H. Res. 1490 shall be considered as read. The resolution provides one hour of general debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on House Administration or their respective designees. The resolution further provides for consideration of H.R. 4795, the Protect Economic and Academic Freedom Act of 2026, under a closed rule. The resolution waives all points of order against consideration of the bill. The resolution provides that, in lieu of the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Education and Workforce now printed in the bill, an amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee Print 119-39 shall be considered as adopted and the bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. The resolution waives all points of order against provisions in the bill, as amended. The resolution provides one hour of general debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Education and Workforce or their respective designees. The resolution provides for one motion to recommit. The resolution further provides that debate on motions that the House suspend the rules, under clause 1 of rule XV, relating to H.J. Res. 1, shall be extended to one hour.
