Page 17, after line 4, add the following:

Subtitle C—Investment in Agricultural Research

3 SEC. 1021. INVESTMENT IN AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH.

4 (a) APPROPRIATION.—In addition to amounts other5 wise made available, there are appropriated for fiscal year
6 2021, out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise ap7 propriated—

- 8 (1) \$300,000,000, to remain available until
 9 September 30, 2023, to fund activities under sub10 section (b); and
- (2) \$80,000,000, to remain available until September 30, 2023, to carry out cooperative extension
 and education programs in response to exigent circumstances created by the COVID-19 pandemic.

(b) ALLOWABLE USES.—The Secretary of Agri-culture (referred to in this substitle as the "Secretary")

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shall use funds made available pursuant to subsection (a)
 to—

3 (1) provide supplemental funding to extend the 4 duration of a grant to an institution of higher edu-5 cation (as defined in section 101(a) of the Higher 6 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1001(a))) or a 7 nonprofit entity that conducts federally funded re-8 search (in this subtitle referred to as a "research in-9 stitution") or National laboratory (as defined in sec-10 tion 2 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (42 U.S.C. 11 15801)) that was awarded prior to the date of en-12 actment of this Act, or to expand the purposes of 13 such a grant in order to— 14 (A) enable a graduate student or post-doc-15 toral researcher to complete work that was dis-16 rupted by COVID–19; 17 (B) enable a principal investigator to com-

18 plete work that was disrupted by COVID-19;

19 (C) extend the training of a graduate stu20 dent or the employment of a post-doctoral re21 searcher on an ongoing research project for up
22 to two years because of the disruption of the
23 job market due to COVID-19;

24 (D) allow for the use of laboratory ani-25 mals, reagents, equipment, or other items re-

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1	quired for research funded by a grant that was
2	awarded prior to the date of enactment of this
3	Act, but need to be replaced, refurbished, or
4	otherwise made usable after disruption because
5	of COVID–19;
6	(E) reconfigure laboratories, restart equip-
7	ment and disrupted research, and other activi-
8	ties necessary to safely resume on-site research
9	activities in laboratories that were temporarily
10	closed or redirected to COVID-19 response;
11	and
12	(F) facilitate other competitively awarded
13	research and training activities that have been
14	disrupted by COVID–19;
15	(2) provide supplemental funding through exist-
16	ing competitively awarded cooperative agreements
17	and contracts to cover the increased costs of con-
18	struction of scientific facilities and equipment that
19	have been delayed because of COVID–19; and
20	(3) award grants and cooperative agreements to
21	institutions of higher education to conduct research
22	on the behavioral, social, or economic effects of
23	COVID–19 and the responses to the disease, or on
24	the effectiveness of such responses.
25	(c) AWARDS.—The Secretary shall—

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(1) develop procedures to award such funds;
 and
 (2) award all such funds as rapidly as possible
 and in no case later than September 30, 2022.

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
