**AMENDMENT TO COMMITTEE PRINT
OFFERED BY MR. HAGEDORN OF
MINNESOTA**

At the end of the committee print, add the following:

1 **Subtitle C—Other Matters**

2 **SEC. 1021. NO NEW SPENDING UNTIL ALL PREVIOUS FUNDS**
3 **HAVE BEEN 80 PERCENT OBLIGATED ON A**
4 **PROGRAM-BY-PROGRAM BASIS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Funds under this title shall not
6 be made available until at least 80 percent of the funds
7 made available under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and
8 Economic Security Act (Public Law 116–136) and the
9 Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (Public Law 116–
10 159) have been obligated.

11 (b) CALCULATION OF THRESHOLD.—For purposes of
12 subsection (a), the Secretary shall calculate the 80 percent
13 threshold on a program-by-program basis.
