I have one brother who acquired the other half of the farm when my father passed, and I buried my other brother in 1998 that passed away from esophageal cancer. I have been married to my wife Tori who is a registered nurse going on 11 years now and have 2 step sons, 1 step daughter, and a step granddaughter.
