Sam Bankman-Fried is the co-founder and chief executive officer of FTX.com, one of the largest digital-asset trading platforms in the world. Sam co-founded the company in 2019 and subsequently co-founded FTX US in 2020 in order to service U.S. customers. Sam is also the chief executive of FTX US. The business was established in order to build a digital-asset trading platform and exchange with a better user experience, equitable access, customer protection, and innovative products, and to provide a trading platform robust enough for professional trading firms and intuitive enough for first-time users.

Sam has personally committed to donating 99% of his wealth and founded FTX Foundation, which has already given over \$100 million this year to alleviate global poverty, provide ventilators to countries ravaged by covid, bank the unbanked, and combat climate change by ensuring FTX is carbon-neutral.

Prior to co-founding FTX, Sam founded Alameda Research, a market-making firm in digital assets, and prior to that worked with Jane Street Capital from 2014 until 2017.

Sam has been recognized as a young entrepreneur on the *Forbes* 30 under 30 list in 2021, and is an important contributor and one of the leading voices and growth drivers in the digital asset ecosystem.
