Page 22, strike lines 17 through 25 and insert the following:

"(5) ALLOCATION AND REDUCTION.— 1 "(A) INITIAL ALLOCATION RESERVED FOR 2 BEGINNING FARMERS AND RANCHERS.—In car-3 rying out this subsection, the Secretary shall 4 first allocate base acres to beginning farmers 5 and ranchers (as defined in section 502(b)(3) of 6 the Federal Crop Insurance Act (7 U.S.C. 7 1502(b)(3))), including beginning farmers and 8 ranchers eligible for an allocation under para-9 graph (8). 10 "(B) REDUCTION.—In carrying out this 11 subsection, if the total of eligible acres allocated 12 to base acres across all farms in the United 13 States under this subsection would exceed 14 30,000,000 acres, the Secretary shall, except 15 with respect to the acres allocated to beginning 16 farmers and ranchers under subparagraph (A), 17 apply a pro-rata reduction to the number of eli-18 gible acres to ensure the number of allocated 19

9	that, for the period of the 2019 through 2023
10	crop years, rented a farm that is eligible under

13	such farm; and
14	"(ii) subject to paragraph (4)(E),
15	may, during the 1-year period following
16	such an allocation, elect to apply such allo-
17	cation to any farm.
18	"(B) PROHIBITION ON DUPLICATION OF
19	ALLOCATION.—The owner of a farm who rents
20	to a beginning farmer or rancher that receives

22	receive an allocation of base acres under this
