

## **Amendment offered by Rep. Jim Costa**

### **Amendment description**

The amendment would strike Subtitle A and insert:

- **Mandatory funds for the Plant Protection Act**
  - Strike \$90 million and insert \$100 million in mandatory funding
    - Funding for the Plant Protection Act Sec. 7721 by \$15 million per year in mandatory funding to \$100 million per year.
  - Strikes \$5 million and increases to \$8 million
    - Not less than \$8 million per year shall be allocated for the National Clean Plant Network.
- **Reinstatement Local Food Purchase Agreement Program**
- **No reallocation of funds from the Ag Quarantine and Inspection Program at APHIS to other programs at DHS for immigration purposes**

Strike subtitle A.

At the end of section 10104, add the following:

1       (g) APIIS OFFICE OF PEST MANAGEMENT POL-  
2       ICY.—Section 614 of the Agricultural Research, Exten-  
3       sion, and Education Reform Act of 1998 (7 U.S.C. 7653)  
4       is amended by adding at the end the following:

5       “(g) MANDATORY FUNDING.— Of the funds of the  
6       Commodity Credit Corporation, the Secretary shall make  
7       available to carry out this section \$8,000,000 for each of  
8       fiscal years 2026 through 2030.”.

In section 10107, strike subsection (a) and insert  
the following:

9       (a) APIIS PLANT PEST AND DISEASE MANAGE-  
10       MENT AND DISASTER PREVENTION.—Section 420 of the  
11       Plant Protection Act (7 U.S.C. 7721) is amended—

12               (1) in subsection (f)—

13                       (A) in paragraph (5), by striking “and” at  
14               the end;

15                       (B) in paragraph (6), by striking “fiscal  
16               year 2018 and each fiscal year thereafter.” and

1 inserting “each of fiscal years 2018 through  
2 2025; and”; and

3 (C) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(7) \$100,000,000 for fiscal year 2026 and  
5 each fiscal year thereafter.”; and

6 (2) in subsection (g), by striking “\$5,000,000”  
7 and inserting “\$8,000,000”.

At the end of section 10107, add the following:

8 (g) MANDATORY FUNDING FOR LOCAL FOOD PUR-  
9 CHASE ASSISTANCE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT PRO-  
10 GRAM.—Of the funds of the Commodity Credit Corpora-  
11 tion, the Secretary of Agriculture shall use \$421,500,000  
12 for fiscal year 2025 to re-establish and expand the Local  
13 Food Purchase Assistance Cooperative Agreement Pro-  
14 gram.

15 (h) COLLECTION OF FEES FOR INSPECTION SERV-  
16 ICES.—Section 2509 of the Food, Agriculture, Conserva-  
17 tion, and Trade Act of 1990 (21 U.S.C. 136a) is amended  
18 by adding at the end the following:

19 “(g) NO REALLOCATION OF FUNDS TO DEPARTMENT  
20 OF HOMELAND SECURITY.—No funds allocated to the  
21 Secretary of Agriculture for the Animal and Plant Health  
22 Inspection Service, or fees collected for inspection services  
23 as authorized in this section, may be transferred or other-

1 wise redirected to the Department of Homeland Secu-  
2 rity.”.

At the end of section 10108, add the following:

3 (d) **CONDITIONAL EFFECTIVENESS.**—This Act, and  
4 the amendments made by this Act, shall only take effect  
5 upon the Secretary of Agriculture reinstating the Local  
6 Food Purchase Assistance Cooperative Agreement Pro-  
7 gram, as established by the agency in fiscal year 2022.
