The amendment would increase and make mandatory funding for hazardous fuels reductions, as well as increase funding for insect and disease management.

Strike subtitle A.

Strike section 10105(d) and insert the following:

1 (d) MANDATORY FUNDING UNDER HEALTHY FOR-
2 EST RESTORATION ACT OF 2003.—

3 (1) HAZARDOUS FUELS REDUCTION MANDA-
4 TORY FUNDING.—Section 108 of the Healthy For-
5 ests Restoration Act of 2003 (16 U.S.C. 6518) is
6 amended—

7 (A) by striking “There is authorized” and
8 inserting the following:

9 “(a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
10 is authorized”; and

11 (B) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(b) MANDATORY FUNDING.—Of the funds of the
13 Commodity Credit Corporation, the Secretary shall make
14 available \$1,220,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2025
15 through 2029 to carry out—

16 “(1) activities authorized by this title; and

17 “(2) other hazardous fuels reduction activities
18 of the Secretary, including making grants to States,

1 local governments, Indian tribes, and other eligible
2 recipients for activities authorized by law.”.

3 (2) INSECT INFESTATIONS AND RELATED DIS-
4 EASES MANDATORY FUNDING.—

5 (A) TERMINATION OF EFFECTIVENESS.—

6 Section 406 of the Healthy Forests Restoration
7 Act of 2003 (16 U.S.C. 6556) is amended by
8 striking “2023” and inserting “2030”.

9 (B) FUNDING.—Title IV of the Healthy
10 Forests Restoration Act of 2003 (16 U.S.C.
11 6551 et seq.) is amended by adding at the end
12 the following:

13 **“SEC. 407. FUNDING.**

14 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Of the funds of the Commodity
15 Credit Corporation, the Secretary shall make available
16 \$100,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2026 through 2030
17 to carry out this title.

18 “(b) RELATION TO OTHER FUNDING.—The funding
19 provided under this title is supplemental to, and not in
20 lieu of, any funding provided under any other law.”.
