

Amendment offered by Rep. Andrea Salinas

Amendment description

The amendment would clarify that nothing in this act has any impact for protections for Inventoried Roadless Areas included in forest plans drafted before or after the Roadless Rule.

AMENDMENT

OFFERED BY MS. SALINAS OF OREGON

At the end of section 10105, add the following:

1 (e) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION REGARDING ROADLESS

2 RULE.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Nothing in this Act shall be
4 construed to change protections for Inventoried
5 Roadless Areas effected by any forest plan, regard-
6 less of whether such forest plan was drafted before,
7 on, or after the date of adoption of the Roadless
8 Rule.

9 (2) DEFINITIONS.—In this subsection:

10 (A) INVENTORIED ROADLESS AREA.—The
11 term “Inventoried Roadless Area” means any
12 area in which road construction, road recon-
13 struction, or logging is subject to regulation
14 under the Roadless Rule.

15 (B) ROADLESS RULE.—The term
16 “Roadless Rule” means part 294 of title 36,
17 Code of Federal Regulations, as adopted on
18 January 12, 2001, and modified for Idaho on

1 October 16, 2008, and for Colorado on July 3,
2 2012, and December 19, 2016.
