

## **Amendment offered by Ms. McClain Delaney**

### **Brief Summary**

This amendment provides \$536 million in funding for the Distanced Learning and Telemedicine and Broadband Programs and strikes the section that cuts SNAP.

Strike subtitle A.

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_.** **CONDITION PRECEDENT TO EXERCISE OF AU-**  
2 **THORITY PROVIDED BY THIS TITLE.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—An authority provided by this title  
4 may not be exercised unless—

5 (1) the total of the amounts made available for  
6 fiscal year 2026 to carry out the programs referred  
7 to in subsection (b) exceeds \$536,000,000; and

8 (2) the amounts are authorized to remain avail-  
9 able until expended.

10 (b) PROGRAMS.—The programs referred to in this  
11 subsection are the following:

12 (1) The broadband loan and grant pilot pro-  
13 gram authorized under section 779 of division A of  
14 the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2018 (Public  
15 Law 115–141; 132 Stat. 399) (commonly known as  
16 the “Rural eConnectivity Pilot Program” or the  
17 “ReConnect Program”).

1           (2) The Distance Learning and Telemedicine  
2       Program under chapter 1 of subtitle D of title  
3       XXIII of the Food, Agriculture, Conservation, and  
4       Trade Act of 1990 (7 U.S.C. 950aaa et seq.).

5           (3) The programs under section 601 through  
6       604 of the Rural Electrification Act of 1936 (7  
7       U.S.C. 950bb—950bb-3)
