

## **Amendment offered by Ms. Craig of Minnesota**

### *Summary*

This amendment strikes all cuts to the supplemental nutrition assistance program made in Subtitle A. It also provides 10-year funding for all orphan programs with mandatory funding lacking baseline.

**AMENDMENT**  
**OFFERED BY MS. CRAIG**

Strike subtitle A.

Page 74, beginning on line 4, strike “\$1,000,000 beginning in fiscal year 2026” and insert “\$5,000,000 for fiscal year 2026 and each fiscal year thereafter”.

Page 74, beginning on line 11, strike “\$10,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2025 through 2031” and insert “\$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2025 and each fiscal year thereafter”.

Page 74, line 21, insert “, and each fiscal year thereafter” after “2031”.

Page 81, line 16, strike “2031” and insert “2025”.

Page 81, after line 16, insert the following (and redesignate the following subsections accordingly):

1       (b) FURTHER FUNDING FOR URBAN, INDOOR, AND  
2 OTHER EMERGING AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION RE-  
3 SEARCH, EDUCATION, AND EXTENSION INITIATIVE.—Sec-

6 ed by subsection (a), is further amended—

Page 81, beginning on line 25, strike “, not later than 30 days after the date of enactment of this clause, \$37,000,000” and insert “\$50,000,000 for fiscal year 2026 and each fiscal year thereafter”.

Page 82, beginning on line 16, strike “\$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2026, to remain available until expended” and insert “\$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2026 and each fiscal year thereafter”.

Page 91, line 9, strike “‘2024’ and inserting ‘2031’” and insert “‘for each of fiscal years 2014 through 2024’ and inserting ‘for 2014 and each fiscal year thereafter’”.

Page 91, line 14, strike “‘2031’” and insert “‘2025’”.

Page 91, after line 14, insert the following:

25 inserting “2031”.

8             riod at the end and inserting “; and”; and

9             (2) by adding at the end the following:

10               “(4) collect and publish cost-of-production data  
11             for organic milk, through support from regional and  
12             national programs, including regularly reported data  
13             related to—

14                 “(A) the costs of major organic feedstuffs,  
15             including—

16                     “(i) the prices for major organic  
17                     feedstuffs produced domestically;

18                     “(ii) the prices for imported major or-  
19                     ganic feedstuffs; and

20                     “(iii) all other costs relating to the  
21                     production of organic milk;

22                 “(B) establishment of an Organic All Milk  
23             Prices Survey, which shall be analogous to the

1 existing All Milk Prices Survey conducted by  
2 the National Agricultural Statistics Service, to  
3 gather and report monthly data about the  
4 amounts organic dairy farmers are being paid  
5 for organic milk and prices received for organic  
6 dairy cows, including—

7 “(i) national data; and

8 “(ii) data relating to, at a minimum,  
9 the 6 regions with the greatest quantity of  
10 organic dairy production; and

11 “(C) periodic organic milk reporting under  
12 which the Secretary, using data collected by the  
13 National Agricultural Statistics Service, the  
14 Economic Research Service, or the Agricultural  
15 Marketing Service, publishes new periodic re-  
16 ports that include, or add to existing periodic  
17 reports relating to, data for organic milk, which  
18 shall be equivalent to data reported for conven-  
19 tionally produced milk.”; and

Page 93, after line 21, insert the following (and redesignate the following subsection accordingly):

serting ‘2031’” and insert “‘calendar years 2014  
through 2024’ and inserting ‘calendar year 2014 and  
each calendar year thereafter’”.

Page 96, beginning on line 11, strike “‘2024’ and  
inserting ‘2031’” and insert “‘each of calendar years  
2014 through 2024’ and inserting ‘calendar year 2014  
and each calendar year thereafter’”.

Page 96, beginning on line 16, strike “‘2024’ each  
place it appears and inserting ‘2031’” and insert
