This amendment strengthens the crypto industry by prohibiting entities seeking registration or exemption under this Act from holding, trading, or facilitating memebased assets associated with public officials, including the President and Vice President, when those individuals have a financial interest in the asset. An important piece of any regulatory regime is ensuring that our leaders work for the American people, and this amendment ensures there are no conflicts of interest for senior government officials.
