

Amendment offered by Mr. Johnson of South Dakota

Amendment description

The amendment would strengthen Tribal 1994 land-grant Institutions by expanding their ability to acquire land, modernize facilities, and invest in equipment to support agricultural research and extension.

Page 401, strike lines 14 and 15 and insert the following:

1 (1) in subsection (b)—

2 (A) in paragraph (4), by striking “land-
3 grant college or university” and inserting
4 “land-grant college or university (except for a
5 1994 Institution (as defined in section 532 of
6 the Equity in Educational Land-Grant Status
7 Act of 1994 (Public Law 103–382; 7 U.S.C.
8 301 note)))”; and

9 (B) by striking paragraph (5); and

Page 459, after line 4, insert the following (and redesignate the following subparagraphs accordingly):

10 (A) in subsection (a), by inserting before
11 the period at the end the following: “and to acquire, alter, repair, maintain, and operate relevant equipment necessary for strengthening
12 the capacity of the Institution to conduct research in the food and agricultural sciences”;

At the end of subtitle E of title VII, add the following (and make such conforming changes as may be necessary):

1 **SEC. ____ . AMENDMENT TO SMITH-LEVER ACT.**

2 Section 3(b)(3) of the Smith-Lever Act (7 U.S.C.
3 343(b)(3)) is amended by inserting after “for the purposes
4 set forth in section 2” the following: “, and for 1994 Insti-
5 tutions to acquire, alter, repair, maintain, and operate rel-
6 evant equipment necessary to strengthen the capacity of
7 such 1994 Institutions to achieve the purposes set forth
8 in section 2”.
