

Amendment offered by Rep. Vindman of Virginia

Amendment description

The amendment would restore SNAP access to Aghan Allies arriving under Special Immigrant Visas (SIVs) and Ukrainians arriving under the Uniting for Ukraine (U4U) program.

Page 238, insert after line 7 the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 **SEC. 4309. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN ALIENS FOR SNAP.**

2 Section 6(f)(2) of the Food and Nutrition Act of
3 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2015(f)) is amended—

4 (1) in subparagraph (C), by striking “or” at
5 the end;

6 (2) in subparagraph (D), by striking the period
7 at the end and inserting “; or”; and

8 (3) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(E) an alien who is present in the United
10 States and who—

11 “(i) is a Ukrainian national paroled
12 into the United States under section
13 212(d)(5)(A) of the Immigration and Na-
14 tionality Act on or after February 11,
15 2022;

16 “(ii) has status as a special immigrant
17 under section 101(a)(27) of the Immigra-
18 tion and Nationality Act pursuant to the
19 Afghan Allies Protection Act of 2009; or

1 “(iii) was paroled in, pursuant to the
2 memorandum entitled ‘Memorandum on
3 the Designation of the Department of
4 Homeland Security as Lead Federal De-
5 partment for Facilitating the Entry of Vul-
6 nerable Afghans into the United States’.”.
