

Amendment offered by Derrick Van Orden (WI-03)

Amendment description

The amendment requires that the source of the fruit or vegetable be indicated on either the front or top of the metal can.

AMENDMENT

OFFERED BY MR. VAN ORDEN OF WISCONSIN

At the end of subtitle C of title III, add the following (and make such conforming changes as may be necessary):

1 **SEC. ____ . METHOD OF NOTIFICATION OF COUNTRY OF**
2 **ORIGIN OF AN AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT**
3 **PACKAGED IN A CAN.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 304(b) of the Tariff Act
5 of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1304(b)) is amended by inserting after
6 the first sentence the following: “In the case of such an
7 article that is an agricultural product (as defined in sec-
8 tion 207 of the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946) pack-
9 aged in a can, the marking required under this subsection
10 shall appear on the front label of the can or be stamped,
11 embossed, or printed on the top of the can.”.

12 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
13 subsection (a) shall only apply to agricultural products im-
14 ported on or after the date that is 18 months after the
15 date of enactment of this Act.
