

Biography – Asaf Meir

Asaf Meir is the Co-Founder and CEO of Solidus Labs, the category-defining market integrity infrastructure company for the global financial system. Under his leadership, Solidus has become the trusted compliance backbone for exchanges, broker-dealers, and financial institutions across both digital asset and traditional markets – a position that has taken on new urgency as frontier markets like tokenized assets and prediction markets move to the center of global finance.

Before founding Solidus in 2018, Meir spent a decade at the intersection of markets and technology – most notably at Goldman Sachs, where he served on the equities trading desk specializing in structured derivatives and electronic trading, and at Microsoft, where he led complex technology products at scale. That rare combination – Wall Street trading mechanics, enterprise technology, and cybersecurity-grade thinking – became the foundation for Solidus’s architecture and product philosophy.

Meir holds a degree in Computer Science and Economics from Brandeis University, where he was the recipient of a full scholarship, and was recognized as the Computer Science Entrepreneur of the Year.

Meir is a frequent expert speaker in media and public forums on market structure, regulatory policy, and the evolution of prediction markets and onchain capital markets. He is closely engaged with regulators, institutional investors, and industry leaders on the structural forces reshaping global finance.

Beyond his professional work, Meir is a dedicated advocate for guide dog training, supporting organizations that provide service dogs to individuals with visual impairments and veterans. When he’s not thinking about market structure, he can be found behind a drum kit.
