

Bob Frazee is the CEO of MidAtlantic Farm Credit, ACA. Headquartered in Westminster, Maryland, MidAtlantic has loans of over \$2.1 billion to over 10,000 members in a territory that covers portions of the states of Maryland, Delaware, Pennsylvania, Virginia and West Virginia. As CEO, he has led the organization through two successful mergers.

Bob's career has been in banking with experience in Farm Credit associations in Maryland, Pennsylvania and Puerto Rico as well as district Farm Credit banks in Baltimore and Columbia, SC. He also has commercial banking experience as a Chief Credit Officer with a community bank in Maryland.

In addition to his responsibilities with MidAtlantic, Bob serves on the Farm Credit System Presidents' Planning Council where he chairs the Regulation-Legislative-Public Relations Committee and the Reputation Management Committee. He frequently is asked to represent the System in public arenas having served as a panelist at Farm Foundation forums at the National Press Club and testifying before the United States House of Representatives Agriculture Subcommittee on Credit, Conservation, Energy and Research on agricultural credit conditions. He was appointed by Governor Robert Ehrlich in 2005 to serve on the board of the Maryland Agriculture and Resource Based Industries Corporation (MARBIDCO) where he served as Chairman for four years during its start-up. He was appointed in 2006 to serve on the Governor's Intergovernmental Commission on Agriculture for the state of Maryland. He served as Chairman of the Md. 4-H Foundation. He represents the University of Maryland, College Park on the national Council for Agricultural Research, Extension and Teaching (CARET) and serves as a member of the Executive Committee.

He earned his B.S. in Agricultural and Extension Education from the University of Maryland, College Park and has done post graduate work in business and banking at The Johns Hopkins University and the Stonier Graduate School of Banking. In April of 2012, he received the Distinguished Alumnus Award from the School of Agriculture and Natural Resources, University of Maryland, bestowed upon an alumnus who has achieved recognition for excellence in their profession or field.
