Revised Report on the Suballocation of Budget Allocations for FY 2015 June 11, 2014 Opening Statement As Prepared

Our last order of business today is to revise the Committee's 302(b)s.

We need to take this action today because --

- 1. We need to reflect the additional disaster cap adjustment that was included in the Homeland Security bill.
- 2. In addition, we are making several reallocations among subcommittees to reflect CBO scoring of bills as they move through the committee process as well as the CJS bill that has passed the House;
 - These reallocations simply move resources from those subcommittees who came in under their current allocation to those subcommittees that can use them. In particular, Financial Services and LHHS received small increases in BA.
- 3. The revised allocations also anticipate the additional outlays, which the Budget Committee intends to provide us.

As we continue to develop our remaining appropriations bills, we are working with the Budget Committee to ensure that we have the outlay resources we need, so additional 302(b) adjustments may be needed down the road.

We need to approve these revised allocations in order to continue being able to bring our appropriations bills to the House floor within the overall spending level set by the bipartisan Ryan-Murray deal.
