



**Yaris Rivera-Rojas, Acting Assistant Inspector General,

Yaris Rivera-Rojas has been the Acting Assistant Inspector General for Audit at USDA OIG since May 2025. In this role, she is responsible for all audits, inspections, and reviews related to USDA's programs, financial statements, and information technology activities.

Ms. Rivera-Rojas started her Federal career as an accounting technician for the Caribbean National Forest in Puerto Rico in April 1994. She joined the Inspector General community in 1996, primarily working with the Department of Agriculture Office of Inspector General, although she spent four years auditing financial installations with the Postal Service OIG. Ms. Rivera-Rojas has been part of the Inspector General community for 29 years and joined the USDA OIG Audit's Senior Executive Team as a Deputy Assistant Inspector General for Audit in May 2016. Additionally, she served as member of the Council of the Inspectors General on Integrity and Efficiency (CIGIE) Monetary Impact Working Group, the CIGIE Mentoring Pilot program and co-lead the Federal Audit Executive Council Annual Conference in FY2025.

Ms. Rivera-Rojas graduated with honors with a BA in Accounting from the University of Puerto Rico – (Humacao) in 1993 and is a licensed Certified Public Accountant in Puerto Rico since 1999.
