The NDAA is the annual defense policy bill which authorizes the Defense Department's \$600 billion budget. Mr. Zakheim previously served as a Congressionally appointed Commissioner on the Commission on the National Defense Strategy of the United States. He currently serves on the National Defense Industrial Association's Board of Directors, the Center for Strategic and Budgetary Assessments' Advisory Council, and the Alexander Hamilton Society's Board of Advisors.

Mr. Zakheim's previous experience includes serving as Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense, where he managed the department's policies and programs related to the Iraq and Afghanistan coalition affairs.
