His work at present continues to focus on China – in particular, on reforming key management processes to ensure a sharper focus not only on growing the enterprise, but on growing shareholder value at state-owned and other companies.

Mr. Glassman has been a featured speaker at management conferences in Shanghai, Beijing, Singapore, Hong Kong, London, Johannesburg, and throughout the United States.
