Catherine Connor is the Vice President of Public Policy and Advocacy at the Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation. In addition to managing the organization's advocacy portfolio, Connor spearhead's EGPAF's U.S. legislative activities and multilateral advocacy engagement on domestic and global health issues.
