Pete DeMarco is the Senior Director of Special Programs for IAPMO. His responsibilities include oversight of IAPMO's water efficiency and green building initiatives, standards development activities, domestic and international plumbing code development programs, industry outreach programs and development of research projects relating to water efficiency.

Pete is the founding member of the Plumbing Efficiency Research Coalition (PERC) and was named as the technical chair of their current research program on building drainline system efficacy in light of the emerging trends towards lower water consuming plumbing fixtures and appliances. Pete also chairs the Energy and Water Efficiency Topical Committee for the National Institute of Building Science's (NIBS) Consultative Council.

Notably, Pete also co-chaired the Steering Committee for Water Efficient Products which fostered the development of the US EPA WaterSense<sup>®</sup> program for efficient plumbing, irrigation and other water consuming products and systems and also served on the Board of Directors and on the Executive Committee for the Plumbing Manufacturers International (PMI).
