The State of Maryland receives an allocation from the Historic Preservation Fund through the National Park Service to carry out the National Historic Preservation Act. In FY12 the grant was \$797,793 out of a total appropriation to the States of \$46.925 million. FY13 MD funding is expected to be the same minus the sequestered amount.

Additionally, while not a grant or a contract, the National Park Service and the National Conference of State Historic Preservation Officers operate a cooperative agreement to fulfill mutual objectives.
