Chairman Nathan Small has served on the seven-member Fort Hall Business Council for a total of six years. In June of 2011, he was re-elected for a second term as Chairman; prior to that, he served as vice-chairman.

He has been a member of the Shoshone-Bannock Tribal Bar Association since 1980 and has held positions as both a prosecutor and public defender in Tribal Court.

Small was instrumental in opening the Shoshone-Bannock Tribes' first gaming operation and served as gaming manager from 1990 to 1998.

Chairman Small also worked for a time in the Tribal Water Resources Department.

He is an avid fisherman, and looks forward to travelling to central Idaho each summer to spear salmon in the traditional way of his people. He and his wife Kitty have four children and eight grandchildren, four of which are being raised by Chairman Small and his wife.
