Amber Bighorse is currently serving as the Lieutenant Governor of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes. Ms. Bighorse has worked for the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes since 2008 starting out as Lead Staff Attorney for the 2nd Legislature. She has also worked for the Tribes as Tribal Council Attorney and Chief In-House Counsel for the Governor's Office. In 2010-2011, Ms. Bighorse worked as an Associate specializing in Indian Law at the firm Hobbs, Straus, Dean & Walker in Oklahoma City. While working at Hobbs Straus, her Indian clients included the Cheyenne & Arapaho Tribes, the Osage Nation, the Wichita and Affiliated Tribes of Oklahoma, and the Absentee Shawnee Tribe. She earned a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and a Bachelor of Liberal Studies in Administrative Leadership at the University of Oklahoma. She attended law school at Oklahoma City University where, in 2008, she earned a Juris Doctorate and a Certificate in Alternative Dispute Resolution.
