She has been with Southcentral Foundation for eight years, first as a family physician in primary care and now as the medical director of quality assurance. She received her medical degree from the University of Washington and completed her family practice residency program in Michigan. She has worked for tribal organizations in Alaska since completing her training in 1991. She has focused her career on providing health care in both urban areas of Alaska as well as remote villages, and partnering with other Alaska Native people to improve the quality of and access to health care services. She served as the president of the Association of American Indian Physicians and remains on the board, and has been featured in publications such as Modern Healthcare magazine and Indian Country Today.
