Ian Glick came to the U.S. Park Police in July, 2005. First assigned to District One, in downtown D.C., Mr. Glick worked as a patrol officer in the Homeland Security Branch and was then assigned to the Baltimore-Washington Parkway in 2009, where he currently works as a patrol officer. He has served as the Chairman of the U.S. Park Police FOP, since 2009.

Mr. Glick began his law enforcement career in 1990 as a member of the U.S. Army Military Police. Following that, he worked with U.S. Department of Treasury, investigating bank fraud, United HealthCare, investigating billing and Medicare fraud, the Immigration and Naturalization Service, field operations, (marine enforcement) in the port of New York. In 2003, he was then transferred to the Department of Homeland Security, Customs and Border Protection.

A native of Illinois, Mr. Glick grew up in Southern Maryland and, though having moved around the U.S. while in the military and afterwards, calls the Washington D.C. metropolitan area his home.
