

**Scott Steen (CEO)** was appointed CEO of American Forests in December 2010. He leads the organization in its mission to restore threatened forest ecosystems and inspire people to value urban and wildland forests. Together with his team, Steen has strengthened the scientific foundations of the organization, creating a science advisory board of some of the most respected researchers in the forest conservation field; expanded public understanding of the importance of forests for human life through several national outreach efforts; and nurtured new partnerships with corporations, federal agencies and other NGOs. During his tenure, the organization has planted more than 15 million trees in hundreds of wildland restoration projects; launched the Community ReLeaf program to expand green space and tree canopy cover in cities across America; and created the Endangered Western Forests Initiative, which is focused on building more resilient forests in the Greater Yellowstone area. Previously, he served as executive director of the American Ceramic Society and chief strategy officer at the American Society of Association Executives.
