

Fawn Sharp is the President of the Quinault Indian Nation serving her third term since first being elected in 2006. She is an attorney with an academic background in Criminal Justice. She holds an advanced certificate in International Human Rights Law from Oxford University. President Sharp formerly served as Managing Attorney and Lead Counsel for the Quinault government, and Associate Judge and as an Administrative Law Judge for the Washington State Department of Revenue Tax Appeals Division. While president of the Quinault Ms. Sharp was elected by the 57 member government organization, the Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians as their President in 2011, and serves as the Northwest Regional Vice President for the National Congress of American Indians. She completed two years of service as Chairman of the US Department of the Interior Secretarial Commission on Indian Trust Administration and Reform that issued its final report in December 2013.
