Tony Small serves as a Member of the Ute Indian Tribal Business Committee as a representative of his Uncompany Band of the Ute Indian Tribe. Mr. Small has lived his whole life on the Tribe's Uintah and Ouray Reservation in northeastern Utah. Mr. Small has been involved in tribal government from a young age and has served the Tribe for more that twenty years. Prior to being elected to the Business Committee, Mr. Small served the Tribe in a variety of positions. Mr. Small worked for the Tribe as a Tribal Loan Officer, Assistant Tribal Treasurer, Assistant Grant Director, and Tribal Accountant. He has also been appointed by the Business Committee to serve on a number of Boards.

As a Member of the Business Committee, Mr. Small oversees the Tribe's development of its energyresources, including, the use of hydraulic fracturing to develop oil and gas resources and the protection of the Reservation's water, natural and cultural resources. Along with the rest of the Business Committee, Mr. Small is also working to address a number of important issues facing the Tribe, including the development of the Tribe's water rights, jurisdiction and law enforcement, youth programs and diversification of the Tribe's financial investments.
