Mayor Hudson's lineage from her mother is Tsimpshian Gish-but-wada Killerwhale Clan and Inupiaq, her father is Navajo-Cherokee, Audrey has resided in her hometown of Metlakatla, Alaska since 1978 and was elected to her current office by tribal membership in 2013.

Throughout her time in office, she has worked to improve professional relationships between tribal and federal government and improving the quality of life for tribal members. Mayor Hudson's priorities include educational and employment opportunities, subsistence rights expansion and economic development.

Prior to becoming Mayor, Ms. Hudson worked in the Administration Department for the Annette Island Service Unit Indian Health Service Facility. Ms. Hudson works diligently to advance the needs of her community now and into the future.
