Mr. Rigdon has been the Yakama Nation Deputy Director of Department of Natural Resources for the last eight years and has worked for the Yakama Nation for over 20 years within the Forestry & Natural Resources. Mr. Rigdon represents the Yakama Nation on the Tapash Sustainable Forest Collaborative, the Yakima River Basin Watershed Enhancement Project Workgroup & Conservation Advisory Group, the Washington State's Columbia River Policy Advisory Group, as well as the Hanford Natural Resource Trustee Council.

Mr. Rigdon obtained a B.S. in Forest Management from the University of Washington in 1996 and earned a Master of Forestry from Yale School of Forestry and Environmental Studies in 2002.
