

Orvie Danzuka is an enrolled member of the Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs and has been recently elected to the Tribal Council. The Tribal Council is second only to the Tribal Membership in the tribal structure. When the Tribal Council is not in session he serves as the Tribal Forest Manager.

Orvie is happily married to Shelia and they have three sons, five granddaughters and one grandson. He is the seventh out of nine siblings. His grandfather served as the chief of the Warm Springs Tribe until his passing and now his uncle has carried that on.

Mr. Danzuka's background is primarily in the Natural Resources field. He took several forestry classes in high school, began taking undergraduate classes in fisheries and eventually rolled the fisheries and forestry classes into a Natural Resources degree with a watershed ecosystems emphasis at Oregon State University (OSU).

Orvie has always enjoyed taking part in extracurricular activities on a local and national level. He has participated in various sports throughout his lifetime. He was president of the OSU chapter of American Indian Science and Engineering Society when they won the National Chapter of the Year Award. He has been elected to the Intertribal Timber Council (ITC) Board and serves as Secretary. Orvie's mother instilled in him the importance of the future generations and their achievements, and he has served as the Chair of the Education Committee for the past three years, which is responsible for selecting recipients and distributing over \$50,000 in scholarships per year.
