Governor Myron Armijo is serving his third term as the governor of the Pueblo of Santa Ana. Prior to his service as governor, he served three terms as the Pueblo's lieutenant governor.

While also serving his Pueblo, Mr. Armijo, for the last 12 years, has served as the tribal liaison for the New Mexico Office of the State Engineer, where he has played a central role on water issues for all 23 tribes within New Mexico.

Formerly, Governor Armijo worked at Los Alamos National Laboratory and Sandia National Laboratory. He is married with three sons.
