Ronald Tehassigotasi which means, “he sits with his feet crossed” Hill Jr. is a veteran councilman of the Oneida Nation. Elected in 2014, as his second term to the Oneida Business Committee, Councilman Hill has spent this term focused on moving forward with a long term vision of sustainability. Sustainability of sovereignty, Oneida language, culture and traditions are the most prominent guiding principles of Councilman Hill.

During his term of office Councilman Hill has served as Audit Committee Chairman, Vice Chairman of both the Legislative Operating Committee (LOC) and Community Development and Planning Committee (CDPC) and is also a member of the Quality of Life (QOL) committee. Councilman Hill also serves as liaison to Oneida Total Integrated Enterprises (OTIE), Oneida Engineering, Science and Construction (OESC), as well as Land Commission and the Environmental Resource Board. Councilman Hill also sits on the Natural Resources Damage Trustee Council and is a designee to EPA’s Regional Tribal Operating Committee. In addition, he previously served on NTOC-EPA.

Councilman Hill was born and raised on the Oneida reservation, is from the Bear Clan and graduated from the Oneida Nation High school – class of 1999. He has also completed two years credited classes at the University of Green Bay studying Business Administration. On his leisure days Councilman Hill likes to spend time hunting and fishing and encouraging his family to be active and engaged in the community. His wife, Michelle Kanatihal-Hill and he share 7 sons and one daughter and nine grandchildren.
