In May of 2016, while serving a term as Rosebud Sioux Tribe Council Representative for the Bull Creek Community, Lisa's father passed away from cancer. Seeing the need to continue the tradition of service, Lisa rose to the occasion and ran unopposed to serve in her father's vacant seat.
