

Bill Whitehead is a member of the Assiniboine and Sioux Tribes of the Fort Peck Reservation in Montana. He is the Chairman of the Board of the Assiniboine and Sioux Rural Water Supply System (ASRWSS).

As Chairman of the ASRWSS Board, Bill is heavily involved with implementation of contracts with the Bureau of Reclamation for the construction of a municipal and rural water supply system on the Fort Peck Reservation.

Bill served as a Tribal Council Member for the Assiniboine and Sioux Tribes from 2003 to 2009. He also served a State Representative in the Montana Legislature for the 1997-98 term.

Bill Whitehead has served on the ASRWSS Board for 14 years and has been Chairman of the board for 7 years. He has been a life-long resident of the Fort Peck Indian Reservation and has been a life-long activist working to improve the lives of all Indian people on the Fort Peck Reservation, State of Montana and throughout Indian Country.
