As a Councilperson on the Quinault Business Committee, he serves on the Quinault and Queets River Committee, the Education and Community Services Subcommittee, the Natural Resource and Community Development Subcommittee, as well as the Land Acquisition Team and the Cannabis Team. Councilperson Hendricks is also a Native American Financial Officers Association (NAFOA) Alternate Representative and serves on the Board of Directors at Greater Grays Harbor.

Councilperson Hendricks has attended the University of Washington Construction Management Program and local Grays Harbor Community College.

Prior to his election as 6<sup>th</sup> Councilperson he was lifelong carpenter and a construction manager. He also owns a small construction company as well as a private fishing guide business on the Quinault Reservation.
