He has dedicated his time as a Tribal Leader and member towards economic expansion, protection of Tribal natural resources, and the health and wellness of tribal members and their families to the place he calls home.

In addition to his Council duties, George is also engaged in various volunteer activities through the community. He strongly supports native rights and has involved himself in historical research activities.
