Kameron Runnels from the Santee Sioux Indian Reservation in Northeast Nebraska, currently serves as Vice Chairman of the Santee Sioux Nation of Nebraska. He represents the Great Plains Region as Vice Chairman of the Great Plains Tribal Leader Health Board, an organization that represents 18 tribes and service areas. He was appointed to the Nebraska Commission on Indian Affairs in 2022 where he serves as board chair. He also serves on two national committees for the Great Plains Region as an alternate delegate for both the National Indian Health Board, and Health and Human Service Secretary Tribal Advisory Committee.
