Kristina Alqayaagaq Andrew is the Third Chief for the Curyung Tribal Council in Dillingham, Alaska. She works as the Senior Tribal Engagement & Infrastructure Development Manager at DeerStone Consulting. Here she works with tribal governments and regional partners to advance infrastructure, energy, and economic development initiatives across the Bristol Bay region. Kristina currently manages the \$8 million SALMONet Tribal Broadband Connectivity Program, supporting broadband planning and digital equity efforts for 16 tribal communities in western Alaska. Previously, she served as Economic Development Program Manager for the Bristol Bay Native Association, where she helped secure over \$2.2 million in funding and developed regional workforce and leadership programs. Kristina holds a Bachelor of Arts in Rural Development from the University of Alaska Fairbanks and was named one of Alaska's Top 40 Under 40 by the Alaska Journal of Commerce in 2024.
