She is a product of tribal college education and earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Teacher Education from Haskell Indian Nations University located in Lawrence, Kansas. She earned a Master of Education Degree and Ph.D. in Educational Leadership and Policy Studies at the University of Oklahoma. She went on to serve in administrative roles at OU as Assistant Director of the McNair Scholars Program and as a faculty member teaching Kiowa Language from 2012 to 2022. Currently, she is the Executive Director of the Kiowa Education Agency and sits on the board of directors for the Tribal Education Department National Assembly.
