Winnebago Tribal Councilman Eugene DeCora Sr. was born and raised in Winnebago, Nebraska, and has dedicated much of his life to serving his Tribal community. Since October 2023, he has served on the Winnebago Tribal Council, where he works to support initiatives that strengthen economic growth and community development.

In addition to his role on the Tribal Council, Eugene currently serves as Board Chair for Ho-Chunk, Inc., a Tribal economic development corporation owned by the Winnebago Tribe. He also serves on the Boys & Girls Club of Hocak Nisoc Haci Board, the Winnebago Gaming Development Corporation Board, the Winnebago Health Foundation Board, and the HUD Tribal Intergovernmental Advisory Committee.

Councilman DeCora is the proud father of six children—three currently in college, one a high school senior, one a freshman, and one a first grader—and has been with his spouse for over 20 years. He earned his Associate's Degree from Little Priest Tribal College, an educational institution established by the Winnebago Tribe. His commitment to family, education, and community service continues to guide his work and leadership.
