Doreen has served in many roles within the North Slope and has focused her career on public health issues for the region. Doreen currently works for Inupiat Community of the Arctic Slope (ICAS), a federally recognized regional tribe in northern Alaska as the Natural Resources Director and focuses on fish and wildlife issues, food sovereignty, and economic development for the north slope region.

Ms. Leavitt has served on many boards nationally, statewide, and locally. She serves as the Tribal Council Secretary for the Inupiat Community of the Arctic Slope (ICAS), represents ICAS on the Inuit Circumpolar Council Alaska, The National Petroleum Council, and the Fossil Energy Tribal Workgroup for the U.S. Department of Energy. She also is a Board of Director for Atqasuk Corporation, an Alaska Native corporation.
