Jon is also Chief Executive Officer of Command Holdings, where he leads the Mashantucket Pequot Tribal Nation's non-gaming investment arm. A member of the Native Village of Afognak, Jon brings decades of experience in Native enterprise leadership, with a career focused on strengthening Tribal economies, building sustainable organizations, and advancing opportunities for Native communities.

Jon has led the integration of multiple acquisitions, while maintaining a unified, values-driven culture centered on respect, accountability, and service. During his tenure, Command Holdings has been recognized as a USA Today Top Workplace twice and has received the U.S. Department of Labor's HIRE Vets Medallion Award four times.

Prior to Command Holdings, Jon served as Chief Compliance and Business Integration Officer at Koniag Government Services (KGS), where he helped guide the organization through a period of rapid growth. He also served as President of the Koniag Education Foundation and CEO of the Kodiak Brown Bear Center.

Earlier in his career, Jon was President and CEO of Colville Tribal Solutions Corporation and served as President of Willapa Bay Enterprise Corporation, the Section 17 corporation for the Shoalwater Bay Tribe.

Throughout his career, Jon has remained committed to advancing tribal economic sovereignty, strengthening Native-owned enterprises, and building organizations that deliver both financial performance and lasting community benefit.
