

**Shan Lewis,  
Vice-Chairman, Fort Mojave Indian Tribe  
President, Inter Tribal Association of Arizona**

Shan Lewis serves as the Vice-Chairman of the Fort Mojave Indian Tribe and President of the Inter Tribal Association of Arizona (ITAA). This is Vice-Chairman Lewis' second term serving as President of ITAA. He previously served as President from 2008 to 2011, and served as Second Vice-President of ITAA from 2006 to 2007.

A veteran of the United States Army, Vice-Chairman Lewis was stationed at Fort Campbell in Kentucky before being deployed for six months in the Sinai Desert in Egypt. Upon completing his tour of duty, he returned to the Fort Mojave Indian Tribe where he worked for the Education and Public Relations Department before being elected by his Tribe.

The Inter Tribal Association of Arizona is an association of twenty-one federally recognized tribal governments that provides a forum to advocate for national, regional and specific tribal concerns and to join in united action to address those concerns. As President of the Inter Tribal Association of Arizona, Vice-Chairman Lewis works to advance the purposes of ITAA, to promote tribal self-governance, and to help improve the quality of life for American Indians living in Arizona.
