J. J. Mulligan Sepúlveda is an attorney at UC Davis School of Law in their Immigration Law Clinic where he supervises law students. He also works in the Clinic as co-counsel on the *Flores* Settlement Agreement and as a *Padilla* expert for the Santa Barbara Public Defenders Office.

Following law school, J. J. worked at a non-profit organization in Brooklyn, New York representing unaccompanied minors in removal proceedings through an Immigrant Justice Corps fellowship. He has also been a Fulbright Scholar at the University of Granada in Spain focusing on unaccompanied minors crossing the Mediterranean.

He has a Bachelor of Arts in International Relations from the University of Nevada, Reno and a Master of Arts in International Relations from IE University in Madrid, Spain. He received his Juris Doctor degree from the University of California, Davis. He is admitted to the New York State Bar and the California State Bar as a registered legal service attorney.

He has provided commentary on immigration issues to NPR, HuffPost, Associated Press and other media outlets. He is the author of *No Human is Illegal: An Attorney on the Frontlines of the Immigration War* published by Melville House.
