## FY 2016 Budget Hearing – Military Construction and Veterans Affairs Related Agencies March 18, 2015 Opening Statement As Prepared

The Committee will come to order. I want to welcome all of you to today's hearing on the four related agencies that are funded through the Milcon/VA bill: The American Battle Monuments Commission; Arlington National Cemetery; The United States Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims; and the Armed Forces Retirement Home.

- The Honorable Max Cleland was appointed Secretary of the American Battle Monuments Commission in June 2009.

- Judge Bruce Kasold has been the Chief Judge of the United States Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims since August 2010, and has served as a Judge on the Court of Appeals since 2003.
- Mr. Steve McManus assumed the role of Chief Operating Officer for the Armed Forces Retirement Home on September 25, 2011. He has been with that agency for 12 years.
